COGNAC 3.55cl

France, 40% Abv, Grape: Ugni Blanc, Cask: New Tronçais & Limousin Oak.
In the 15th century, the delivery of Cognac region wines is made difficult by the 100 Years War & travels badly. So, they decided to distil & transport it in barrels to the Dutch kingdoms, where they will call it "burnt wine" or in Dutch: "brandewijn", hence the English term brandy.
Ristéard Ó hAonghusa was born in 1724 in Cill a Mhuilinn in County Cork, he left Ireland to escape English oppression. Enlisted in the Irish brigade of the King of France, he became an officer in the Regiment of Clare. Afterward he moved to the charente region to open a brandy trading company & a distillery that will carry his name: Richard 'Hennessy.'

VODKA 3.55cl

The original uses were not for drinking casually, but rather for medicinal uses and as a remedy against very cold weather. The word Vodka comes from the translation of water in Russian: “Voda”. Try one of our Irish vodka, ‘Kalak’ the Celtic Queen of Winter, elegant texture with hints of biscuit. ‘Assaranca’, infused with berries from the “the lady of the hills” (the rowan tree) and blossom from the gorse that protects faerie castles, it has fresh sweet grassy notes, hints of earthy coconut water. Or Ballykeefe, six times distilled through their bespoke copper column for an impeccable purity.

TEQUILLA, MISCAL 3.55cl

Tequila is typically produced by steaming the agave inside ovens before being distilled in copper pots. Mezcal, on the other hand, is cooked inside earthen pits that are lined with lava rocks and filled with wood and charcoal before being distilled in clay pots in a traditional method, which is the source of the smokiness commonly associated with mezcal.

UISCE BEATHA EIREANNACH 3.55cl

Have It Neat, On The Rocks or With Water

Distilling in Ireland began in the 6th century when monks brought the Mediterranean technique to create perfumes. Rather than using fruits & flowers, the Irish used the local cereal crops as ingredients, and the “Eau de Parfum” became “Eau de Vie” AKA “Water of life“. The oldest written records of whiskey are in the Annals of Clonmacnoise dating back to 1405.

SINGLE POT STILL

Made with at least 30% malted and 30% unmalted barley and could be added up to 5% of other cereals such as oats and rye if required. Mainly triple distilled in large pot stills from a single distillery. That results in a higher strength which is light in aroma yet particularly sweet in taste. Usually spicy and distinctively mouth-coating style. Single Pot still is exclusively made in Ireland. In 1800s Distillers due to the escalating taxes on Irish malted barley began cutting it with green barley. This incorporation of unmalted barley to the mash gave it a unique distinctive spiciness known as ‘pot still character’.

SINGLE GRAIN

Single Grain Irish Whiskey are produced from malted barley (not exceeding 30%) and includes whole unmalted cereals usually maize or wheat. From a single distillery and can only be distilled through column still (also known as Coffey still). Mostly triple distilled, usually sweet, light, with floral top notes

SINGLE MALT

Single Malt are distilled from nothing other than 100% malted barley at a single distillery, usually in smaller copper pot. These contribute to an intensity of flavoured spirit of great complexity and diversity. May be double but mainly triple distilled. The Organoleptic Characteristics are usually smooth, sweet, and malty.

CASK STRENGTH

Cask strength Whiskey does not just do what it says on the tin, it is the tin, and everything in it. Whiskey is usually diluted with water before it is bottled, following distillation and maturation in casks. Cask strength, scandalously, hits the bottle straight from the barrels. Cask strength Whiskey is also non-chill filtered, a process that usually removes chemical compounds following maturation. That is why cask strength Whisky can go a bit cloudy, which is perfectly natural, and why some people love it, it is not missing anything.

BLENDED

Blended Irish Whiskey is an art. Master blenders gain the same respect in the industry as master distillers. They are responsible for ensuring the quality of existing brands and innovate to create new ones as tastes change. They use their experience of flavours to choose from a range of parameters including whiskey type, distillery of origin, cask and age to produce each of the finished products. They will use one or two lighter whiskeys and overlay one or more Malt Irish Whiskey or Pot Still Irish Whiskey to achieve their desired flavour and consistency. The skill is to retain or enhance the component flavours but the whole is inseparable from the parts. A blend is a mixture of two or more styles of Irish whiskey. There are no specific names to differentiate between blends made from such or such. The flavour profile varies, but generally smooth, mellow, and silky.

SINGLE MALT

Single Malt is made entirely from malted barley in copper pot stills. It is a product of a single distillery and is traditionally double distilled (triple distilled in Ireland).

It must be aged in an oak cask for at least three years and one day.

Peat is a natural resource used since the ages. It was used in the early days of the whiskey industry to dry the barley over a peat fire to protect it from moisture and bacterial infection. It gives a certain smokiness to the whisky and is measured in parts per million (ppm) of phenols in the barley before being milled.

Bourbon must be made of a grain mixture that is at least 51% corn. Aged in new, charred, white American oak barrels for a minimum of two years. Whiskey is differentiated by maple charcoal-filtered prior to aging, it is referred to as Lincoln County Process or “charcoal mellowing.”
